



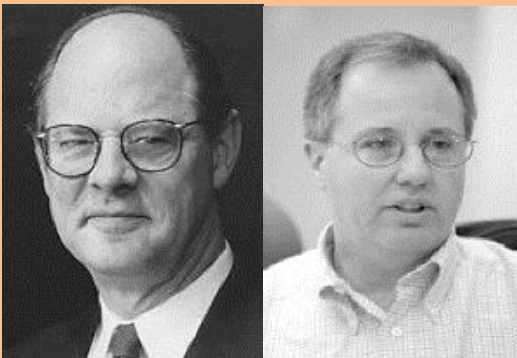

Dick Stevie and George Vredeveld will return this year to give their 12th Annual Economic Forecast to our organizations. These two economists will combine economic statistics, their expert knowledge, and a little bit of movie trivia to predict the leading indicators of the economy in 2012. ASQ, APICS, and SME will once again join forces with ISM-C to host this meeting.

Dick Stevie has been General Manager, Market Analysis Department for Duke Energy Corp. since 1996. In this capacity Dick is responsible for forecasting, market research, load research, and energy efficiency program design. Dick serves as Chair of the Cincinnati USA Partnership's Economic Advisory Committee. Mr. Stevie has a BA in economics from Thomas More College, and an MA and Ph.D. in economics from the University of Cincinnati. George Vredeveld, the founding director in 1977 of UC's Economics Center for Education and Research, has proven to be one of the most effective leaders in the movement to promote

economic education in a meaningful way to school-age children. In 2002, the UC center was singled out from among 250 centers of its kind around the nation to receive the first-ever outstanding performance award from the National Council on Economic Education. The following year, he was voted President elect for the National Association of Economics Educators. Dr. Vredeveld has a BA from Calvin College, MA from Purdue, and a Ph.D. in economics from Indiana University.

ISM Certification Review Seminars



ISM-Cincinnati Certification Review Seminars will be held For five consecutive weeks beginning Saturday February 3, 2012 and concluding March 4, 2011. The review seminar series will be conducted by Don Johnson an ISM Certified Trainer.

The criteria for the CPSM credentials are:

- Three years of full time professional supply management experience
- Bachelors degree from an accredited institution
- Pass all three CPSM exams or pass the CPSM Bridge Exam if you are currently a C.P.M.

The criteria for the CPSD credentials are:

- Pass the CPSD exam
- Pass the CPSM exam one or be a current CPSM

The criteria for the CSM are:

- Three years of full time experience and an associate's degree or five years of full time experience
- Pass the three CSM exams or pass the SCM bridge exam if you are currently a C.P.M.

The review sessions will be held in the Student Union at Northern Kentucky University, room 105 from 9 am until 1 pm. The campus is conveniently located just south of the junction of I-475 and I-275 in Highland Heights, Kentucky just eight miles south of downtown Cincinnati.

Candidates for the CPSM, CSM and both of the Bridge exams will attend sessions one thru four.
Candidates for the CPSD will only need to attend the first and fifth sessions.

Registration for either the CPSM Review or CSM Review is **\$695** and includes participant manual, Diagnostic Kit, Study Guides, Professional Series Books (3 volumes), and the ISM Glossary.

Registration for either the CPSM Bridge Review or the CSM Bridge Review is **\$445** and includes participant manual, Diagnostic Kit, Study Guides and the ISM Glossary.

Registration for the CPSD Review is **\$345** and includes participant manual, Study Guides and Glossary..
